

## **THE AMERICAN PILOT**

**What:** Play by David Greif, a Scottish playwright.

**Storyline:** The topic is how individuals are affected by large-scale global conflict, and about the difficulty and importance of overcoming cultural differences. An American plane crash-lands in a rural valley of a war-torn country. Will the villagers help the wounded pilot, ransom him, or execute him? Written in advance of the Iraq War, this staggeringly poetic script attempts to give a more human voice to those whom we're used to labeling as "insurgent" or "combatant."
