### **Official MIC World Travel Raffle Rules:**

1. The World Travel Raffle is administered by the Minnesota International Center (MIC), a 501(c)(3)-registered nonprofit organization. Lawful Gambling Exempt Permit #X-04980 expires 10/29/10.
2. Prize: One (1) prize includes vouchers for two Delta Airlines "H"-class, coach class roundtrip Pacific route airline tickets. Vouchers are available to use with no blackout dates and are based on seating availability. Vouchers must be redeemed before May 26, 2011. Winner is responsible for redemption of vouchers and all travel arrangements. The approximate value of the vouchers is up to \$2,400 each, or \$4,800 total, and is based on estimated airfare pricing for two-week travel found on the Delta Airlines at the time of prize selection. MIC's raffle records shall be deemed correct if there is any discrepancy in the name of the raffle winner. MIC is not responsible for resolving any disputes that may arise from different individuals listed on a valid World Travel Raffle ticket.
3. Only cash or check are valid payment methods for purchasing World Travel Raffle tickets. Tickets may not be purchased with a credit card in accordance with MN State Gambling Control Board regulations. Tickets must be sold for the price printed on the ticket, and may not be provided free of charge or for any other consideration. All purchases of World Travel Raffle

tickets are non-refundable. There is no limit to the number of tickets an individual may purchase.

4. World Travel Raffle ticket purchaser, and anyone to whom an entry purchaser legally transfers an entry, must be an individual 18 years or older at time of entry purchase. Only one (1) individual may be identified as the purchaser (or buyer) of the raffle entry. Purchase of only one (1) World Travel Raffle ticket is required for official entry. All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply. World Travel Raffle tickets may be purchased via mail or in person. Ticket may not be purchased online in accordance with MN State Gambling Control Board regulations. Ticket confirmation number(s) will be mailed to all purchasers at the billing address provided during the purchase. Any and all email communications will be sent to the email address supplied during the purchase. It is the purchaser's responsibility to provide a valid, deliverable mailing address and/or email address to the Minnesota International Center (MIC). MIC and its agents, Board, staff, volunteers and members assume no liability for lost, late, misdirected, mutilated, incomplete, illegible, undelivered entries or entries without proper payment received, which entries shall be deemed invalid and shall be immediately disqualified. MIC's staff members and immediate family of staff members are not eligible to participate in the World Travel Raffle. By entering the World Travel Raffle, the entry purchaser acknowledges that he or she is aware of, and agrees to abide by, the Official World Travel Raffle rules and regulations. One (1) individual World Travel Raffle entry will be randomly drawn at the 10<sup>th</sup> *WorldQuest* International Trivia Competition, taking place at 7:00 PM on Friday, October 29, 2010, in Memorial Hall at McNamara Alumni Center, 200 Oak St. SE, Minneapolis, MN 55455. Winner need not be present to win, and will be notified by phone or in writing at the contact information provided on the raffle entry ticket. The chance of a valid single ticket entry winning a prize shall be based on the total number of valid entries received for the World Travel Raffle.
6. All winners, by entering, authorize MIC to publish their name and likeness on MIC's website ([www.micglobe.org](http://www.micglobe.org)) and for it to be used in other MIC communications and/or promotional materials.
7. All winners shall be responsible for any and all federal, state and local income or excise taxes, fees, assessments and like charges associated with the prize.

World Travel Raffle ticket purchasers, by participating (and winners, by accepting a prize) release the Minnesota International Center and its respective staff, board, committee members, volunteers, partners, vendors, agents, representatives, sponsors and members from any and all liability with respect to participation in the promotion and possession or use of the prize awarded, and also acknowledge that they did not receive any representations, warranty or guarantee, express or implied, in fact or in law, relative to any prize, including but not limited to its quality, mechanical condition or fitness.
